Malaysian Palm oil futures fell by 2.02% in early trade today Tuesday 30/4/2024 by RM 79 to RM 3836(\$ 804.19) per ton on lower crude price and lower export estimates. In Dalian palm oil slipped by 1.51% and Soy oil by 0.65%. Soy oil fell by 1.44% at Chicago.

99,150 TONS ONION EXPORTS ALLOWED TO NEIGHBOURING COUNTRIES

The Government has allowed to export 99,150 tons of on to the neighbouring countries such as Bangladesh, UAE, Mauritius and Srilanka. Onion prohibition has been imposed due to lower crop estimates in rabi crop and made ensure to adequate domestic supply.

GOOD RCN YIELD AFTER DELAYED CROP SEASON

Due to adverse climate affects during this year cashew crop season have been delayed start now crop yield is reported as good in almost major growing regions. Yield is good and prices are hovering between Rs.95 to Rs.100 per Kg. Rainfall have not accured after the crop season till the end of this month and is supported the crop growth. Prices of raw cashew nuts are lower as compared to other crops and are discouraging farmers.

CARDAMOM PRICES INCREASED

Small Cardamom prices have been increased, due to lower production because of excessive heat weather. Demand also have been increased. Due to excessive heat summer weather and shortage of water facility to the crop production have been dropped according to the news sources. Production in Guatemala have been dropped due to adverse climate affect and prices of that origin Cardamom also have been increased.
