## PADDY SOWING AREA UP BY 16% TO 394.28 L.H

Kharif paddy sowing area in India reached to 394.28 lakh hectares. Sowing are increased by 16% from 384.05 lakh hectares during the corresponding period of last year's kharif season. Paddy production could increase and prices of rice could ease after kharif harvest. Increased planting area could help to increase production and supply can be increase.

# ARHAR OR TUR SOWING AREA REACHED TO 45.78 LAKH HECTARES

Kharif Arhar or Tur sowing area increased to 45.78 lakh hectares from 42.11 lakh hectares during last year's corresponding period (as of August 23). Significant increase in sowing area could help to increase Tur production and increase in Tur and tur dal supply. Prices likely to reduce from current level due to higher production and supply.

### MOONG SOWING AREA INCREASED FROM 30.64 L.H TO 34.07 L.H

Moong sowing area during current kharif season have been increased from 30.64 lakh hectares during corresponding period of last years Kharif season to 34.07 lakh hectares. Moong and moong dal prices already have been reduced to some extent and likely to come down further due to higher production.

### URAD SOWING AREA LOWER AT 29.04 L.H FROM 31.10 L.H

During current Kharif season Urid planting area is lower from last year's Kharif sowing area in corresponding period. Sowing area dropped from last year's 31.10 lakh hectares 29.04 lakh hectares. Production could slightly reduce from last year's production could keep urid price higher. Prices could drop at harvesting season but can rice after depending upon supply position with imports. Total pulses sowing area have been increased from 115.55 l.h in during last year's corresponding period of Kharif crop to 122.16 lakh hectares upto 23 Aug 2024 according to NSFM data.

### SOYBEAN SOWING AREA ROSE TO 125.11 L.H FROM 124.71 L.H

Soybean sowing area during current kharif season till 23 Aug reached to 125.11 L.H from 124.71 L.H during the corresponding period of last year's kharif season. Production could be stable or likely to increase slightly from last season as sowing area have been increased.

### SUNFLOWER SOWING AREA UP AT 0.17 L.H FROM 0.67 L.H

During current kharif season sunflower sowing area slightly increased form 0.67 l.h during last kharif season's corresponding period to 0.71 lakh hectares till Aug 23, 2024. Increase in production of oilseeds could help to reduce edible oil imports during this year.
