EDIBLE OIL PRICES UP ON INCREASING DEMAND

As festival season started in India demand for edible oil increasing. Due to lower availability edible oil prices are increasing. Palm oil price have been significantly increased. Coconut oil prices also increased due to lower supply. SUnflower oil, groundnut oil prices also on increase. Prices likely to stay higher during festival season.

HIGHER IMPORTS AFFECTING DOMESTIC BLACK PEPPER PRICES

According to the news sources Black pepper is arriving to India through imports from countries such as Vietnam, Brazil, Shreelanka and Indonesia. Eventhough prices of Black Pepper is higher in global market, it is lower than Indian domestic pepper. Imports in largest quantity is affecting domestic pepper prices according to the news sources. Price have been increased during some days earlier now begun to falling. Increased availability of imported pepper could affect prices of domestic pepper. Prices could remain higher the last year as global supply is lower than demand.

CASHEW PRICES HIGHER ON INCREASING DEMAND AGAINST LOWER SUPPLY

Raw cashew nut prices have been increased due to lower domestic and global production. Supply is lower than demand. Cost of production have been increased and raw nut supply is lower. Demand for cashew kernels are increasing during festival season and supply being tight prices goes on increasing. Prices likely to stay higher during current season.

MOONG, MOONG DAL PRICES LOWER ON NEW CROPARRIVALS

Moong,moongdal prices have been decreased to same extent due to new crop arrivals. Usually moong, moongdal prices are decreasing at the time of new crop arrivals. During this season production could be good on favourable climate and increased sowing area in kharif season. Prices could remain lower on increasing arrivals. Good demand on festival season could help to keep prices at reasonable level.

URAD, URID DAL PRICES COULD DROPAFTER NEW CROPARRIVALS

Every year usually urid and urid dal prices droping after new crop arrivals. Production likely to be good on favourable climate. New crop arrivals could begin from September end or October and prices likely to drop from October onwards.s
